Uniforms

U6's- U8's will receive their uniform shirt at training towards the end of March and you must ensure they have their uniform to wear each week. Purchase shorts, socks and shinpads at sign on, or from the Canteen (open for merchandise during the first few training weeks, and on Saturdays during the Season).

SENIORS will have playing jerseys provided each week. One team member will be responsible for washing the playing shirts each week. The training shirts will be provided at training towards the beginning of the season.

All players must wear black soccer shorts, St Cats socks, soccer boots and shin pads. Shin pads and boots are also required for all training sessions. Please do not place any of the uniform shirts into the dryer as they may shrink or the printing may come off.

Parent Participation

The Club is a community organisation and each family is expected to help out during the season - at least 2 field set ups, and 1 additional task.
